



Anglesey: road cycling route

Distance (km)	Instruction	Notes
0	Start at Castle Car Park. Beaumaris LL58 8RA (GR 53.265531, -4.088120). Turn left out of car park onto B5109	Plenty of refreshment facilities and carparking
2.4	Turn right towards Penmon/Llangoed	
4.4	Left turn to Penmon village	
5.9	At sharp L bend go straight across junction (avoiding the downhill into hamlet)	
6.7	Take right turn at T-junction.	
10.9	Continue on road to Llandonna.	
12.5	After village turn R following signs to Pentreath.	
12.7	Left turn towards Pentreath	
15.2	Turn right on B5109 to Pentreath.	
19.1	Turn right at Pantons Arms onto A5025.	
20.7	After Rhos-y-Gad Campsite, turn left following signs to Llanbedrgoch	
23.6	Turn left onto B5108.	
24.7	At T-junction turn right onto B5110.	
27.4	Turn left onto A5025 towards Amlwch	
28.2	At roundabout take second exit onto the A5108 into Moelfre	Moelfre is a picturesque former fishing village; great cafes and food
30.2	Drop down into harbour, then re-trace route back up hill to right turn, opposite store, towards Rhos Lligwy.	
33.1	At A5025 turn right	
36.1	Take right towards Dulas Bay	
38	Take right towards Dulus (signed to church) and continue on minor road	
42.9	Turn sharp right then immediately right again on road to Port Eillian following cycle route 566	
43.8	Turn left following route 566 and continue on small lane	
46.5	Arrive Amlwch Port (public toilets) and continue through village	Historic port from which copper was exported all over the world; plenty of refreshments; public toilets at the port
47.5	At T junction (opposite snooker hall) turn right, after 20 m take	



	right onto A5025 towards Cemaes.	
53	Turn right at unmarked junction towards sea, continue through Llanbadrig	
57	At A5025 turn right, after 200 m turn right again into Cemaes Bay. Continue along the High Street to A5025	Pretty little harbour and two great beaches
61.4	At roundabout take first exit towards Llanfechell, then continue around road to right following signs to Tregale	
63.7	At A5025 turn right, then immediate left onto route 566 towards Cemlyn	
67.6	Turn right to follow route 566	
72.5	Turn right (at the post box) towards Church Bay	
73	After church turn right towards Church Bay for viewing, public toilets and café. Or continue along current route	Rural and unspoilt sand and pebble beach with rock pools.
79	After cemetery at Llanfaethlu take a right towards Llanfwrog	
84.1	Right turn onto A5025 towards Valley	
87	Right turn onto cycle route 5.	
90.1	At junction with A5 turn left then right to follow route 8	
90.7	Turn right onto B4545, bridge over A55, then first exit off roundabout following route 8	
91.9	Left turn to follow route 8.	
93.1	At junction turn right following route 8	
94.4	Left turn following route 8 around the fence line of the military base	RAF Valley – don't be surprised if the Red Arrows do a low flypast
97.5	Right turn following route 8	
99.9	Turn right leave route 8 towards Rhosneigr	
103.8	Turn right onto A4080 towards Rhosneigr	
104.3	Turn right into Rhosneigr	Large sandy beaches, and a mecca for watersports. Full range of refreshments.
108.9	Complete loop of Rhosneigr and, turn left onto A4080	
109.3	Turn right, before church towards Ty Croes and keep left when	



	passing railway station.	
112.6	Turn right towards Aberffraw.	Aberffraw has a large dune-backed sand beach and full range of refreshments
115.5	Turn left onto A4080 for 100m, then right through the village. As the road sweeps right turn left alongside Crown Inn. Go over stone bridge, take right along lane through dunes.	
120.7	At A4080 turn right	
122.9	Before Maltreath Bridge turn left towards Trefdraeth	
125.8	Turn right over stone bridge on route 8	
128.4	Turn right onto B4419 then immediately left onto route 8	
129.5	Turn left to continue on route 8	
131.5	Turn left to continue on route 8	
137.4	At A5 turn right, then immediate left to follow route 8 towards Star	
139.3	Keep straight into B5420 ignoring right turn to follow route 8	Llanfairpwllgwyngyllgogerychwyrndrobwyll-llantysiliogogogoch (aka Llanfair Pwllgwyngyll) is the longest railway station name in UK
139.7	Turn right onto B5420 to Plas Menai	
142.0	At roundabout take second exit (straight over) following signs to Plas Menai and pick up route 8 again	Menai Bridge – take a walk to the base of the Menai Suspension Bridge; watch the turbulent waters rushing through the Strait. Plenty of pubs & cafes to visit
143.1	At roundabout take second exit on to A5	
143.4	At roundabout at Anglesey Arms take first exit onto A545 towards Beaumaris	
144.9	Turn left, following route 5 towards Llandegfan uphill	
145.1	Ignore route 5 signs off to left and continue uphill	
146.2	At T-junction turn right (left turn signed to Llandegfan)	
148.5	At cross-roads turn right	
150.2	At A545 turn left into Beaumaris	
151.4	Arrive back at car park
