



## South Harris: road cycling route

Distance (km)	Instruction	Notes
0	Start at Leverburgh Ferry Terminal and continue following signs to reach the A859 towards Tarbert. Climbing steadily once you leave Leverburgh.	Grab a hot drink or bacon butty at the Butty Bus or grab a bite at the Anchorage Restaurant (also takeaway)
7.8	Descend to reach the sands at Sgarasta Bheag	Turn off the A859 towards Northton for warming soup and cakes at the miniscule hobbit house next to the sea – The Temple
13.7	Pass the entrance to the fabulous Machair Kitchen and then onto Horgabost and Seil	The seafood is good and even if just stopping for a drink the views off the balcony are simply stunning
16.6	Pass Seilebost with access to the incredible beach with views across to Luskentyre. Climb to the high point of the ride and then on the descent look for the turn-off to The Golden Road, Miabheag etc.	
29.1	Turn right along the single-track Golden Road, Miabheag etc.	At Drinisiader pass the Harris Tweed and Knitwear shop and museum
45.2	In Greosabhagh at the T junction turn left towards Cliuthar	The Bay's Centre is a community café with plenty of good homemade fare and interpretation centre, near Lacklee
56.6	At Finsbay, in front of Bays of Chocolate, continue left and follow signs to Rodel	
62.9	Descend into in Rodel, past St Clement's Church and then ascend and descend the hill on the A869 to Leverburgh	Just after the church sample some excellent seafood at Sam's Seafood shack
67.6	Arrive Leverburgh
